You might feel a bit like a prisoner in your own home at the moment. Write or draw the BEST THING about lockdown and the thing you find HARDEST.

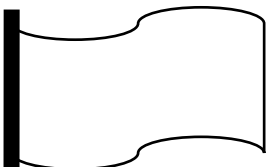
THE BEST THING IS...
