Matthew 28 v 16-20

Find the book of Matthew in the New Testament, find Chapter 28 and read verses 16-20.




Jesus said that his disciples would have the same authority and power on the earth as he had done.

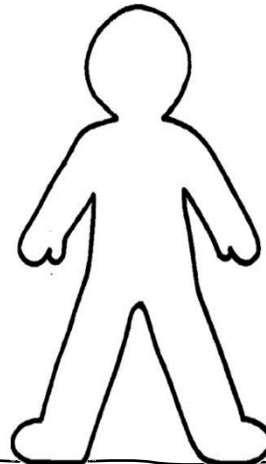
When you think about Jesus on the earth what are some of the things that he did?
