The candle or glowstick represents Jesus the light of the world.

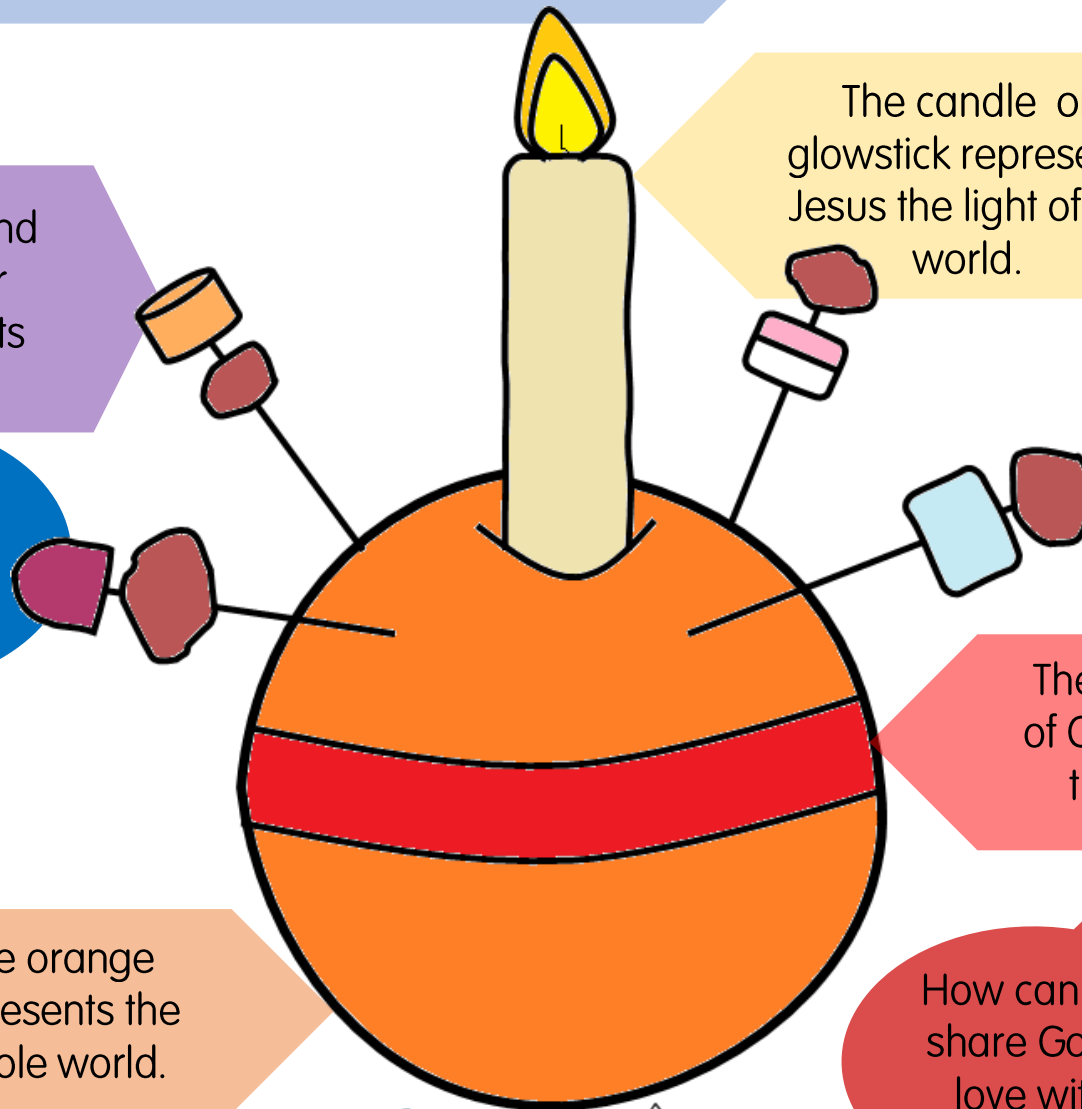
Why do you think Jesus described himself as the light of the world?
